Subject: Request for a 60-day Extension for the Misfueling Mitigation Public Comment Period

Dear Administrator Jackson:

The Agency published its proposal to mitigate the misfueling of vehicles on November 4, 2010, with comments due by January 3, 2011. We, the undersigned parties, request an extension of EPA's comment period by 60 days to allow stakeholders the opportunity to offer complete and thoughtful comments. The complexity involved with this rulemaking, as evidenced at the public hearing on November 16, requires the complete attention of all stakeholders which is impossible to achieve due to the scheduling of this comment period. Effectively, three of the eight weeks contained in this comment period fall around Federal holidays that take many in the U.S. out of the office.

In order for the most complete and thorough comments to be offered to this complex proposed rulemaking, the undersigned parties respectfully reiterate our request that EPA extend the comment period by 60 days allowing stakeholders to devote their full attention to it in 2011.
