Results from ABBRA 2010 Wage Rate Survey Available

Marine association generates yardstick for measuring employment wages and benefits

WARREN, RI –Results from the American Boat Builders & Repairers Association (ABBRA) 2010 Wage Rate Survey are now available. The survey results, generated via input from ABBRA members and other members of the marina and boatyard industry, allow employers to gauge whether they are fair and competitive in the employment market. Employees and independent contractors can also research whether they are getting the correct compensation for their work.

“The Wage Rate Survey is a particularly important resource in today’s economy,” Doug Domenie, president of ABBRA, says. “Many employers may be considering whether or not they have to cut jobs or salaries in the future. The survey is an accurate depiction of real salaries and benefits, and helps the industry’s workforce to maintain consistency and high standards.”

With the Wage Rate Survey, ABBRA members can compare their employees’ salaries to others in the same region and nationwide for many job types. It contains information about hourly wages, average vacation time, benefits, and pension plans across a range of job categories, including general manager, technician, store manager, rigger, dockhand, and bookkeeper.
